Meadow Lane Elementary School New Administrative Offices and Multi-Purpose Gymnasium



The construction crew has been busy working on our new building. Meadow Lane is resembling the architect's drawing (above) more every day. We love watching all the progress and will be excited when we are finally able to move in. We are hoping to be able to move in during the holidays this year. There have been some shipping delays on major components for the building.

We have seen so many contractors on site working. Painting contractors completed painting all of the interior areas. Windows, trim and all outside doors have been installed. A water main has been installed across the current bus loop lot. The gymnasium and cafeteria are coming together, all basketball hoops have been installed. The ventilation hood for the stove has been installed in the kitchen. Heating and air conditioning units were installed in June.

You can really see the changes outside. There was a big push to finish paving the parking area before school began which included pouring concrete curbs and sidewalk areas. The wrought iron fencing was reinstalled at the front of the school and sprinkler lines were trenched and installed the last few days. Concrete walking paths have been installed as well as asphalt on campus behind the building. The office front desk area is framed and interior windows and door frames are installed. A beautiful wall was built to secure a classroom area from the parking area.

CHARACTER

Each month Meadow Lane spotlights a different Character trait.

August and September's character trait is *Empathy*. *Empathy*

is being able to know how someone else is feeling, even when you aren't in the same situation.

Each teacher and all of our staff will be looking for students who are exhibiting this trait. Please talk to your child about what empathy looks like for you and your family at home as well as ways they can demonstrate empathy at school.

Each teacher nominates students from their class who have been "caught" often demonstrating the character trait of the month. These students will receive an award from our Principal and Vice Principal.

3-5 YEARS

- DESCRIBE AND LABEL Help children recognize their emotions and body, "You're clenching your fists. You stomped your feet. You seem angry."
- READ STORIES and discuss the character's feelings.
- Make a WE CARE CENTER.
- Coach their SOCIAL SKILLS.

5-7 YEARS

- Use PICTURES Cut out pictures from magazines or print pictures that show sad, angry, or happy faces.
- EMBRACE DIVERSITY Help children understand what they have in common with others.
- OBSERVE OTHERS Note the body language of others and guess haw they might be feeling.
- Teach about HEALTHY LIMITS and their own boundaries.









- Engage in highlevel DISCUSSIONS about book characters.
- Try loving kindness MEDITATION.
- Engage in cooperative BOARD GAMES.

9-11 YEARS

- Sign up for ACTING CLASSES.
- Create EMPATHY MAPS - Choose an emotion, then brainstorm what you might say, think, and do when you feel that way.

12+ YEARS

- Discuss current EVENTS.
- Encourage your child to choose VOLUNTEER WORK.
- Try "WALK THE LINE" activity perfect for classrooms, summer camps, or other places with a large group of older children/teens.

If your child is sick, please follow these guidelines for when to keep your child home:

- A temperature of 100 degrees or above
- Students must be fever-free without fever-reducing medication (such as Tylenol or Motrin) for at least 24 hours before returning to school
- Vomiting and/or diarrhea. Student may return to school 24 hours after last episode
- Uncontrollable cough or wheezing or shortness of breath
- Suspected communicable disease (i.e. chicken pox)
- Suspected infections
- A rash of unknown origin student may return to school when written authorization is received from the health care provider
- Students must stay home for the first 24 hours on antibiotic therapy






